1. Students brought home their SuperKids textbook. Students will read both stories for the week, "The Lesson" and "That Was Yesterday.". They will have to make sure they have both superkids pages 11-12 done.

2. Attached are two stories that students will need to read and write down the answers to the questions on a piece of paper that they will turn in. These stories are also in the packet. They will also need to identify and write down all the words that have the same vowel pattern.

The two stories are called:

-Shark by the Shore

3. Attached as well as in the packet is the "ot" family where students will have to read the words at the top, read the four boxes, put the words in ABC order, and write to the words next to the meaning.
